ELinux Wiki Facts

- License:
 - GNU Free Documentation License
 - Compatible with Wikipedia (still?)
 - License for code excerpts: GPL
- Allow/encourage linking to other sites
 - No need to be one-stop repository
- Need to log in to create or modify content
- In general, uses Wikipedia guidelines
 - Except: original research is allowed (and encouraged)

Highlight - Did you know...?

Squash FS was accepted into the mainline kernel, and is now in the 2.6.29-rc tree? SquashFS is a compressed, read-only filesystem, commonly used in many existing embedded Linux systems. Phillip Lougher, the Squash FS maintainer, was sponsored by CELF to push this code to mainline. It had been used as patches outside of mainline for many years.


